Te Pire mō te Hararei Tūmatanui o Te Kāhui o Matariki: Te Kāhui o Matariki Public Holiday Bill Approval for Introduction

Portfolios Associate Arts, Culture and Heritage (Hon Kiri Allan) / Workplace Relations and Safety

On 23 September 2021, the Cabinet Legislation Committee:

- **noted** that the Government has committed to introduce a Bill to establish a Matariki Public Holiday before the end of 2021;
- 2 Confidential advice to Government
- noted that the Bill will establish a new public holiday and set the dates the holiday will be observed on for the next 30 years [CAB-21-MIN-0241.01];
- 4 **noted** that the Bill is a dual language Bill in English and te reo Māori [CAB-21-MIN-0241.01];
- confirmed that the Bill should not include a statement outlining how to approach any discrepancies between the two versions;
- approved for introduction the Te Pire mō te Hararei Tūmatanui o te Kāhui o Matariki/Te Kāhui o Matariki Public Holiday Bill [PCO 23516/8.0];
- 7 **agreed** that the Bill be introduced on 27 September 2021;
- 8 **agreed** that the Government propose that the Bill be:
 - 8.1 referred to the Māori Affairs Committee for consideration for a period of five months;
 - 8 2 Confidential advice to Government
